❖ Who is eligible to enrol?

All who are first-year college students and older, of ANY academic or professional background, are eligible for the courses. There is no upper age limit. Enrolment is on a first-come, first-served basis.

❖ Can I enrol in both courses?

Yes.

❖ What kind of educational background and skills are required?

The courses are open to all. Anybody with motivation and enthusiasm to learn, enhance their skills, and build professional relationships with co-participants and the faculty should enrol in the course(s).

Participants in the Institute on Election 2019 & Political Journalism will need to be able to comprehend spoken Hindi and spoken English. Participants in the Introduction to Journalism Institute will need to be able to understand spoken English.

We anticipate participants from diverse backgrounds – students, journalists, lawyers, writers, publishers, public relations personnel, business people, other members of the general public – from Delhi and from across India.
- ❖ Will I receive a certificate upon completing the course?  
Yes. You will receive an Academe India Certificate of Acknowledgement upon completion of a course, signed by the course co-conveners and the Academe India Head of Research.
